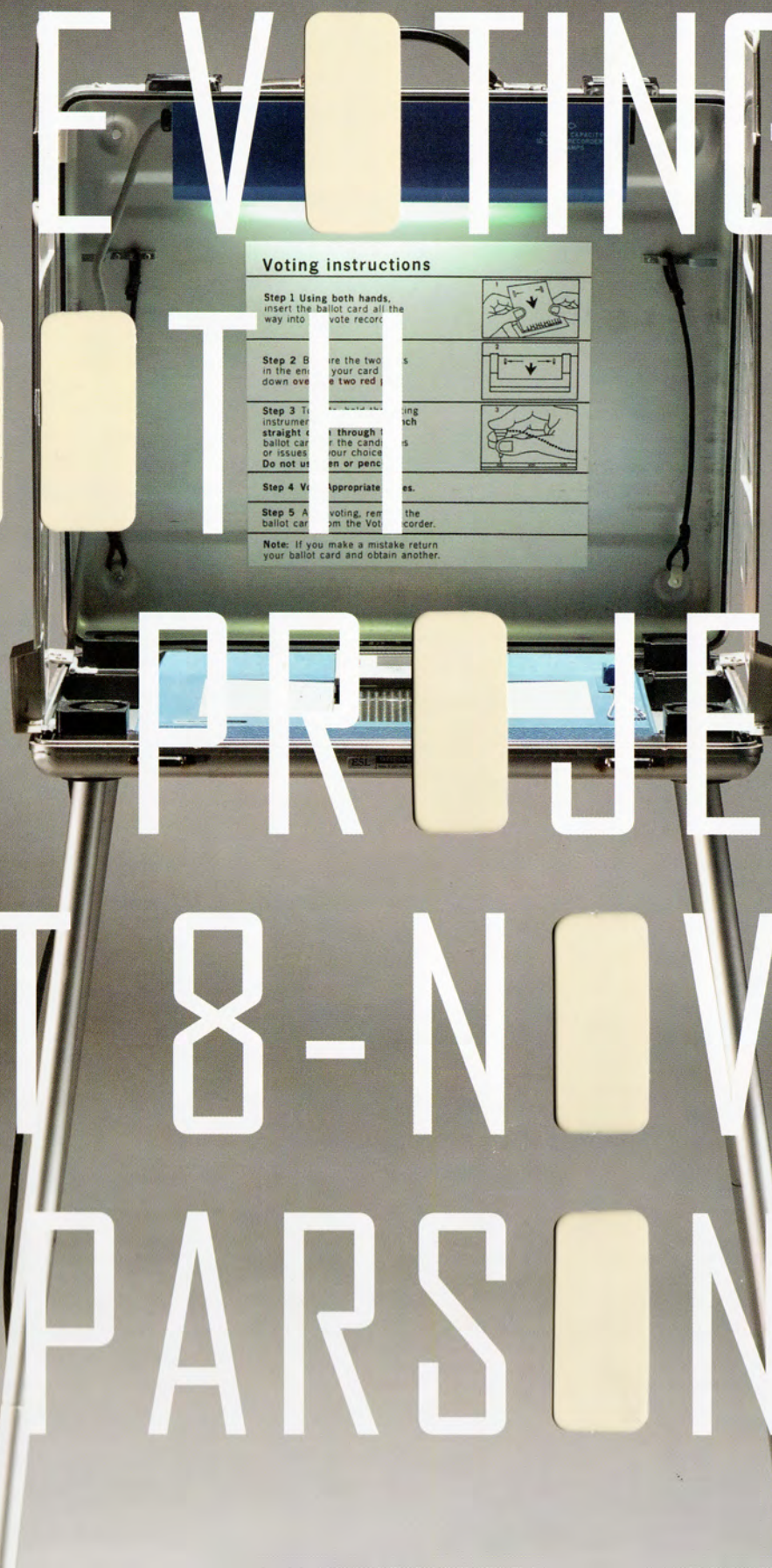


THE VOTING BOOTH PROJECT OCT 8 - NOV 15 PARSONS

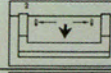


Voting instructions

Step 1 Using both hands, insert the ballot card all the way into the vote recorder.



Step 2 Before the two red lines, turn the card down over the two red lines.



Step 3 To mark your choice, use the instrument straight through the hole for the candidate or issues. Do not use a pen or pencil.



Step 4 Vote for all appropriate issues.

Step 5 After voting, remove the ballot card from the vote recorder.

Note: If you make a mistake return your ballot card and obtain another.
